All the Ex-Com members are Persons with MS and serve on a voluntary basis.

It is the only Multiple Sclerosis Patients' representative federation recognized by the Athens Court of First Instance (Decision No. 6403/2009).

HFoPwMS is a member of the National Confederation of People with Dis abilities (NCPD) and an Associate Member of European Multiple Sclerosis Platform (EMSP).

Latest Achievement

- Concluded a Pan-hellenic survey on patients' views on their illness, the burden of those who suffer and their families, symptom management and support needs.
- Concluded successfully talks with the Greek Ministry of Labor in order to include PPMS & SPMS in the list of non-reversible diseases with benefits for sufferers.
- Concluded successfully talks with the Ministry of Health for the creation of a National MS Registry (one HFoPwMS Excomember is included in the working committee).
- National Health Service Provider EOPYY,
 satisfied HFoPwMS' standing request for
 the granting of eight (8) physical therapy
 sessions per month per year to sufferers of MS with kinetic disabilities.
